Sleeping over at Bell Heath

Bell Heath is set in 20 acres of secluded woodland grounds with accommodation for up to 72 students in our main house and additional space on the camp site. To ensure the best residential experience for visitors all our accommodation is sole occupancy meaning no other schools will be sharing your space.

Main block: Consisting of 72 beds set in a classic single storey building. There are 9 dormitory style rooms sleeping 8 in each room.

Campsite: Our large 10 man tents are ideal for spending a first night away under canvas.

Additional needs: Groups that have users with additional needs can be accommodated with easy access throughout the building with disabled showers and toilets. We have hydraulic beds to make life easy.



Staying at Malvern

Our Malvern Centre is set in 9 acres of secluded woodland grounds, with accommodation for up to 100 students, split into 3 separate areas within the site. To ensure the best residential experience for visitors we aim to keep groups together within their own accommodation block and not share facilities with other groups.

South block: consists of 56 beds set in a classic single storey building.

North Block: is a modern style brick building with 44 beds and its own dedicated common room and skittles alley.

Our Chalet: features disabled access and accommodates smaller groups of up to 18 people. Our Scandinavian style wooden-built chalet is set on one level and also includes disabled toilet and shower facilities.
